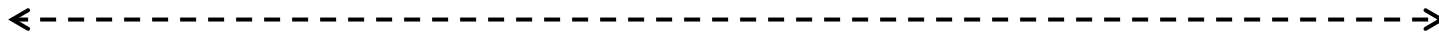

"Because EVERY youth deserves a trained leader!"

The new Basic Leader Training program is a must for every leader. The skills and knowledge obtained in these training courses are vital to a well-run, well-organized, and well-prepared unit. The time and effort you invest in training will not only give you the tools and confidence to be a good leader, but it will also DIRECTLY benefit every Scout you work with. Follow these steps to become a TRAINED LEADER!

- **Step 1: YOUTH PROTECTION (Video tape/DVD or on-line)**

For any new volunteer with or without a scouting position. Youth Protection Training is a BSA-developed course that gives adult leaders/volunteers the tools and guidelines to help keep our youth safe. Valid for 2 years, then take it again. www.sgvcbasa.org click the on-line training link. You will need your member ID# that is on your bsa registration card.

- **Step 2: FAST START (Video tape/DVD or on-line)**

Viewing this introductory video or on-line course is critical and should be viewed by the new volunteer immediately after registering and before meeting with any youth. Fast Start videos for all levels of Scouting are available at the SGVC Smiser Scout Center and may also be viewed via the internet by going to www.sgvcbasa.org and clicking on the "training" signpost. You will need your member ID# that is on your bsa registration card.

- **Step 3: THIS IS SCOUTING (On-line only)**

THIS IS SCOUTING is the BASIC foundation course for all additional training that highlights the values, aims, methods, history, organization, and funding of Scouting. This 60-minute course is taken only once and need not be repeated when a leader takes on a new leadership position. (www.sgvcbasa.org)

- **Step 4: LEADER SPECIFIC TRAINING (Live audience participation course)**

Leader Specific Training is a series of courses that provides specialized knowledge that a new leader needs to assume a leadership role. To be trained as a Boy Scout Leader, you must complete the "Outdoor Training" portion as well (see below).

- **Step 5: OUTDOOR TRAINING (Hands-On Courses)**

Outdoor training is required for ALL Boy Scout Leaders. An Outdoor Leader WEBELOS version is also available, as at least one Cub or WEBELOS Leader accompanying a pack on a camping activity must have this training.

For Cub Scout Leaders:

B.A.L.O.O. (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation) is an introduction to Pack camping, BSA resources available for camping, and the Cub Outdoor Program. Remember, that is MANDATORY on all tour permits that every Pack camping activity has at least one leader that is B.A.L.O.O-trained.

Outdoor Leader Skills for WEBELOS Leaders is a comprehensive camping and outdoor skills course geared for the more advanced level of outdoor activities at the WEBELOS level. It is also MANDATORY on all tour permits that every WEBELOS camping activity have at least one leader that is Outdoor Leader Skills for WEBELOS Leaders-trained.

For Boy Scout Leaders:

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills teaches skills out of the Boy Scout Handbook and is also great training for Venture leaders. This required course is needed by all Scoutmasters and their Assistants, as well as by Varsity Scout Coaches, in order to be fully trained.

For Venture Leaders:

Venturing Leader Specific Training is designed to introduce adult Venture Crew leaders to the basic information needed to operate a crew. Chartered Organization Representatives, Venture Crew Advisors, Associate Advisors, Crew Committee Members, Commissioners, and other adults involved with Venturing should attend.

Venture Youth Protection is an enhanced safety course that gives guidelines and addresses the specific and unique issues that adult leaders face in a Scouting program that involves both boys and girls.

Now that you've completed BASIC training, keep sharp & up-to-date. Attend additional training!

SUPPLEMENTAL TRAINING

Roundtable: A monthly training session that provides program planning and implementation training.

High Adventure Training: Specialized outdoor training courses that include Winter Awareness, Backpacking, Rock Climbing, Canoeing/Water Trek, Desert Awareness, Leave No Trace, Orienteering, Outings Ldr, Wilderness Aid.

POW WOW: Conference-style all day adult Cub training in a wide variety of topics.

ADVANCED TRAINING

Wood Badge: A training course that focuses on strengthening leadership skills. This course is available to all Cub, Boy Scout, Varsity, or Venture leaders who have completed their Leader Specific Training.
